INTRODUCTION TO CLINICAL IMMUNOLOGY for the Students of English Dentistry Division, Medical University of Warsaw

GENERAL RULES

- The Introduction to Clinical Immunology course is conducted in the second year, during the winter semester. It consists of 5 seminars (each lasting 90 minutes) and 10 lectures, for a total of 20 teaching hours (10 hours of seminars and 10 hours of lectures).
- 2. Lectures are organized in five cycles of two. The first cycle is held in person, while the remaining lectures take place synchronously on the MS Teams platform. Attendance and acquaintance with the lecture content are mandatory and will be verified. To receive credit for an online lecture, a student must be actively present for at least 50% of its duration.
- 3. Seminars are held in person. Attendance at **all seminars** is mandatory and will be verified via attendance lists.
- 4. In exceptional cases, a student who misses a seminar or a lecture cycle due to medical reasons must make up for the missed class either orally (by answering three questions related to the seminar/lecture topic based on the assigned reading list) or in writing, in agreement with their assistant. A scanned copy of the medical certificate must be sent by email to the Secretariat of the Department of Immunology (immunologia@wum.edu.pl) no later than 7 days after the absence.
- 5. Each student is allowed **one excused sick leave absence** from a seminar and **one excused sick leave absence** from a lecture cycle.
- 6. The course concludes with a written test (colloquium) held during the final seminar. The exam covers all topics discussed during the course; up to **15% of the questions** will be based on lecture material. A passing grade requires at least **50% of correct answers**.
- 7. Students are expected to prepare for each seminar based on the assigned reading materials. Preparation is required to successfully complete the seminar. The reading list for each seminar is provided in the course schedule.
