INTRODUCTION TO CLINICAL IMMUNOLOGY for the Students of English Dentistry Division, Medical University of Warsaw

GENERAL RULES

- The course of Introduction to clinical immunology is held in the second year, in the winter semester and consists of 8 seminars (lasting 1 hour and 30 minutes each) and 10 lectures. Entry in the student's index: 15 hours of seminars, 10 hours of lectures, total - 25 hours.
- 2. The seminars and the first two lectures will be held at the University Center of Dentistry, MUW. The remaining eight lectures will be delivered on the Microsoft Teams platform at the time specified in the class schedule. Lectures and seminars are mandatory.
- 3. The course ends with a colloquium in test form at the last seminar. All topics from the class are applicable; up to 15% of the questions will be arranged based on the knowledge presented in the lectures. To pass the colloquium, more than 50% of the questions must be answered correctly.
- 4. Students are required to prepare for class from the issues that are the content of the current seminars. This is required to pass the given seminar. The reading list for each seminar is provided in the schedule.
